


Get in shape for HealthWatch

It will enable you to build your case and respond to the challenges that the new health and social care agenda and the transition to HealthWatch will bring.

Containing an assessment graph and a set of criteria to help you measure how your LINK works with its members and participants, partners and the community, it will help you demonstrate your effectiveness and identify the areas of competence your LINK needs to work on as it evolves into HealthWatch.
